Thank you for your interest in volunteer opportunities with Atlanta Ronald McDonald House Charities. Volunteering at one of our Houses can be a rewarding experience, and it's just one of the many ways you can make a difference in the lives of children and their families.

Volunteer placements are made by matching current service opportunities with the interests and availability of potential volunteers. If we identify a match with your application, our director of volunteer services will contact you for a personal interview. If no volunteer positions are currently available, your application will be kept on file for six months to identify a potential match in the future.

Volunteer Your Time

Our families, along with our staff, rely on volunteers to honor their commitment to Ronald McDonald House®.

To participate in our program, you must:

- Be at least 16 years old (except for summer volunteer program for teens)
- Submit an application
- Pass a criminal background check
- Agree to volunteer for at least six months, subject to our needs
- Attend a volunteer orientation and training session
- Follow through with any additional training your placement may require
- Adhere to Ronald McDonald House policies and procedures



How You Can Help Individual Opportunities

With the guidance of the volunteer coordinator, our volunteers serve by working a set schedule within one of the following are as:

- **Guest Services Volunteer** For outgoing individuals who have a warm and pleasant attitude and are interested in helping to provide a more comfortable stay for our families. *Responsibilities include:* greeting visitors and guests, answering phones, providing family and community tours, checking families in and out, cleaning and organizing around the house and general administrative duties. **Time Commitment** *Two-hour shift weekly or bi-weekly*
- **VolunTEEN Program** For high school students, ages 15–18, who are looking for a rewarding way to spend their summer break, this program offers hands-on volunteer work. Openings are available on a first-come, first served basis. **Time Commitment** *Two-hour shift, weekly for eight weeks*
- **College Volunteer Program** A 12-week college program session during the fall and spring semesters. **Time Commitment** *Two hour shift weekly or bi-weekly for 12 weeks*
- **Emerging Leader's Council:** For young professionals interested in volunteering and raising awareness and funds to help meet the needs of the families served by ARMHC. For more information, please contact ELC@armhc.org

- **Family Meal Program** For individuals or groups able to commit to one night monthly, quarterly or throughout the year by preparing and serving dinner Monday–Sunday or weekend Brunch. **Time Commitment** *3–4 hours monthly, quarterly or weekly*
- **Casserole Club** An extension of our Family Meal Program created for the many individual volunteers who are interested in providing a meal for the families. Program available Monday – Friday at 10am or 2pm. **Time Commitment** *Two hours monthly, quarterly or weekly*
- **Baker's Club** Everyone enjoys homemade sweets every now and then! Our families always love it when fresh baked cookies, brownies, cakes and other goodies are available to enjoy. Program available Monday-Friday at 10am or 2pm. **Time Commitment** *Two hours monthly, quarterly or weekly*
- **Family Activity Program** For individuals or groups wishing to share their time and talents to provide arts and crafts activities, games nights, manicure nights, performances etc. for the children and their families. Program available Monday-Thursday at 7pm. **Time Commitment** *Two hours monthly, quarterly or weekly*
